



## **New Day's Mission**

New Day is a non-profit organization, established as a donor circle, dedicated to improving the lives of women and girls in crisis throughout Asia. Our focus is on “engagement” and members have the unique ability to select and implement grass roots projects, becoming more intimately involved in the lives of the individuals we seek to impact. Our intent is to establish a bridge between New Day members and the communities that we support, thus creating greater awareness of the issues impacting women in crisis in Asia.

## **Our Focus**

The organisations we fund provide women and girls with basic needs or assist them to improve their lives through education and economic empowerment. Our aim is to have a long term impact on the communities that we support. New Day works in partnership with grassroots charities and other established foundations to conduct appropriate due diligence and monitoring. We are funded by the regular contributions of a membership circle in Hong Kong along with donations from our corporate partners. New Day is run entirely by volunteers with all costs borne by the members themselves. This ensures that close to 100% of the funds raised go directly to our projects.

## **Since founding in 2007:**

- New Day has funded 14 different project in Laos, Vietnam, China, Nepal, Cambodia, India, Sri Lanka and Hong Kong. In this time we have made 19 grants to these projects totaling over US\$250,000.
- We have raised over \$75,000 in co-funding from our corporate partners. We have conducted 11 site visits to Laos, Nepal, Cambodia, India and Sri Lanka.
  - 14 New Day members and 12 representatives from our corporate co-funders have participated in these visits.
  - We currently have 59 monthly contributions with an annual membership income of just over \$50,000.

New Day works in partnership with established charities and organizations. By working with established foundations and grassroots charities, New Day is able to conduct appropriate due diligence and monitor projects as they are implemented. Also, by utilizing the existing infrastructure of other, larger organizations, New Day members are ensured that almost 100% of their contributions directly finance our projects.

## Our Current Projects

### **Daughters of Cambodia** [www.daughters.org](http://www.daughters.org)

Daughters is an NGO based in Phnom Penh that provides employment and a fair wage to women and girls leaving the sex industry. It currently employs over 80 women in its Cafe, Shop, Sewing Room and Jewelry-making businesses. In addition to jobs Daughters provides a safety net of health care, counseling, creche and family outreach for all the women who work there. New Day has been supporting Daughters since 2010.



### **Children's Surgical Centre** [www.csc.org](http://www.csc.org)

Children's Surgical Centre is a hospital in Phnom Penh that provides free non-emergency surgeries to patients who come from all over Cambodia to benefit from its care and expertise. New Day has been supporting CSC since 2008 and we are currently funding their Obstetric Fistula program.



### **LOVEQTRA Girls School and Home** [www.loveqtra.org](http://www.loveqtra.org)

LOVEQTRA is an NGO operating in the Qinghai province of China. It runs the Sengchemdrukmo Girls Vocational Training School (SGVTS) for Tibetan girls on the Tibetan Plateau. SGVTS provides residential care and schooling in the local curriculum and English to 120 girls who have escaped orphanage or domestic bondage. New Day has supported SGVTS since 2008.

Kalki Welfare Society is an NGO in Pondicherry in the Tamil Nadu province of India. Kalki runs a Drop In Centre for street children and a Night Shelter for street girls. A Girls Program provides the girls at Kalki with educational support and life skills and works with partner NGOs to place them in vocational training programs and job placements. Kalki is actively involved in the community of Pondicherry. New Day has supported the Kalki Night Shelter and Girls Program since 2009.



### **Shakti Samuha** [www.shaktisamuha.org.np](http://www.shaktisamuha.org.np)

Shakti Samuha is a support organization for girls leaving the sex industry in Pokhara, Nepal. It is run under the umbrella of Child Welfare Scheme in Nepal (CWS Nepal). Shakti runs a half-way home for girls in need of residential care and provides ongoing support to help these and many other girls to reintegrate into society, reunite with their families and continue their education or attend vocational training. New Day started supporting Shakti in 2012.
